## 06-603 REMOTE STARTER BUTTON



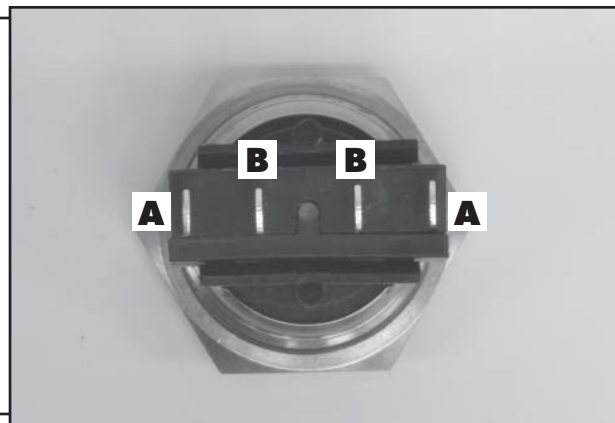
 **MAINTENANCE:** To keep your new chrome billet saddlebag latch covers looking their best, we recommend applying a high-quality chrome polish to them every time you detail your motorcycle.

### BILL OF MATERIALS

1	Starter button assembly

**WARNING:** Your safety depends on the correct installation of this kit. Use appropriate service manual procedures. If the procedures are not within your capability or you do not have the correct tools, have a trained mechanic/technician install this part for you. Improper installation of this part could result in injury or death.

**STEP 1:** The Battistini's remote starter button is for custom applications either as a starter button (when used with a starter relay) or as a kill switch (with or without a relay). To wire as a starter button, the two outside terminals (A) are used, one for power in, one for power out. This allows power to flow through the switch **when** the button is pressed. To wire as a kill switch, the two inside terminals (B) are used, one for power in, one for power out. Power flows through the switch **until** the button is pressed. In this manner the switch can be used in conjunction with a relay to instantly cut the ignition, or it can be used as a momentary switch requiring the button to be held down until the engine completely stops running.



**STEP 2:** Mounting the switch assembly requires a 3/4" hole. The micro switch snaps into the push-button assembly, and removes just as easily. Use the provided nut and rubber gasket when installing this switch.
